

Some exciting news about i-develop


When you sign on to i-develop at www.i-develop-cld.gov.uk you will note that the site has changed. This is part of a refresh of the i-develop platform. Not only have we given i-develop a new look but we have, as part of a growing commitment to the CLD field provided new functions which we hope will help you grow as CLD practitioners.

For example, we've created a new space for upload of thematic practice materials and resources - we hope this makes it easier for you to find materials relevant to particular areas of work such as adult learning, adult literacies, capacity building, work with young people etc.


We have also created a new areas under MY CPD, these being MY Group Space a feature which enables you to develop a discrete space where you can work with a group of other practitioners online in your own dedicated space using a discussion forum. Once set up it is simple and easy to use.
