Who are we?

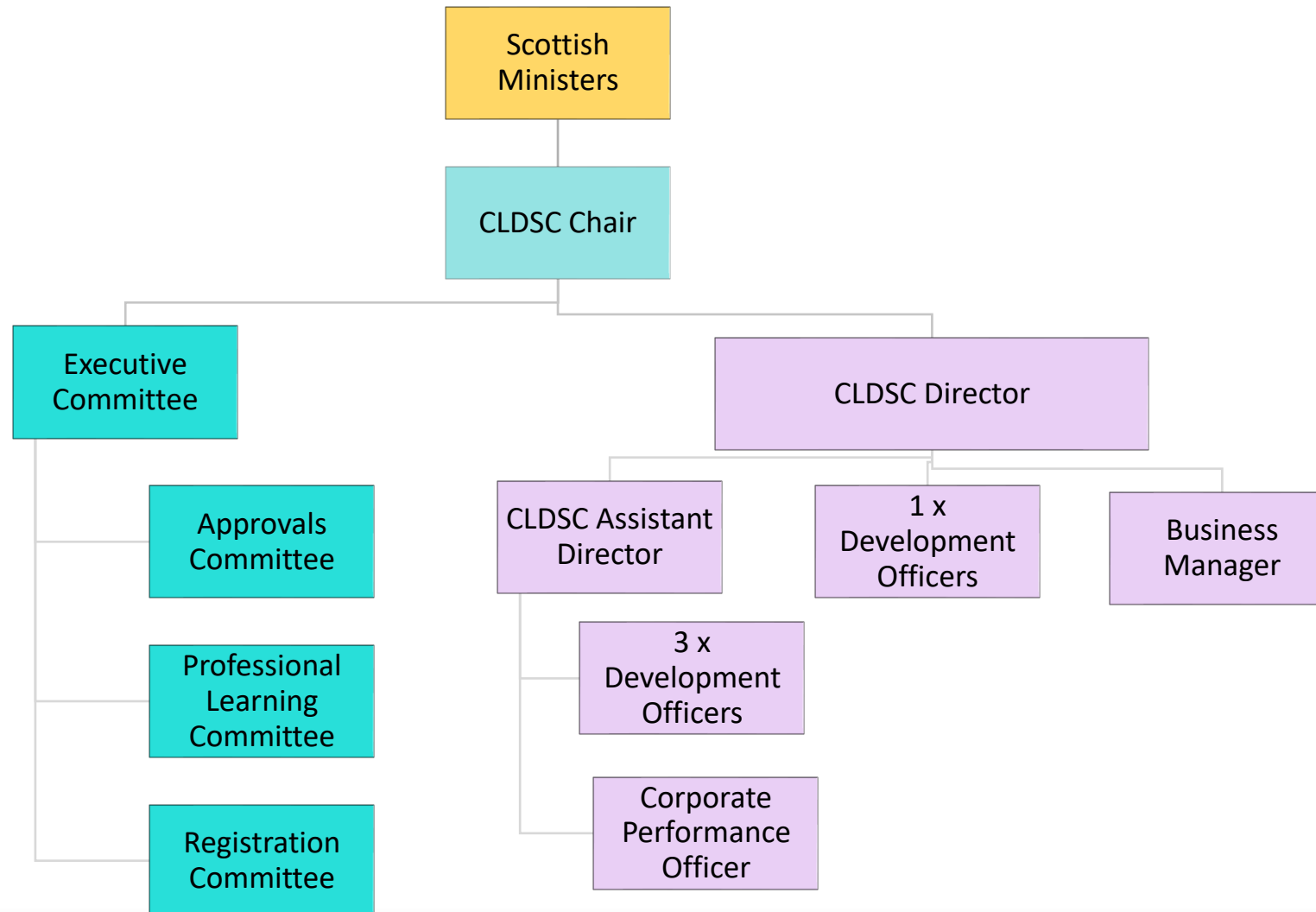
- Established in December 2008 by Scottish Ministers.

- Represents CLD practitioners who work and volunteer in: adult learning (including literacies & numeracies and ESOL); community development; and youth work.
- Chair is appointed by Scottish Ministers & our current chair is Alan Sherry OBE.

Our Priorities

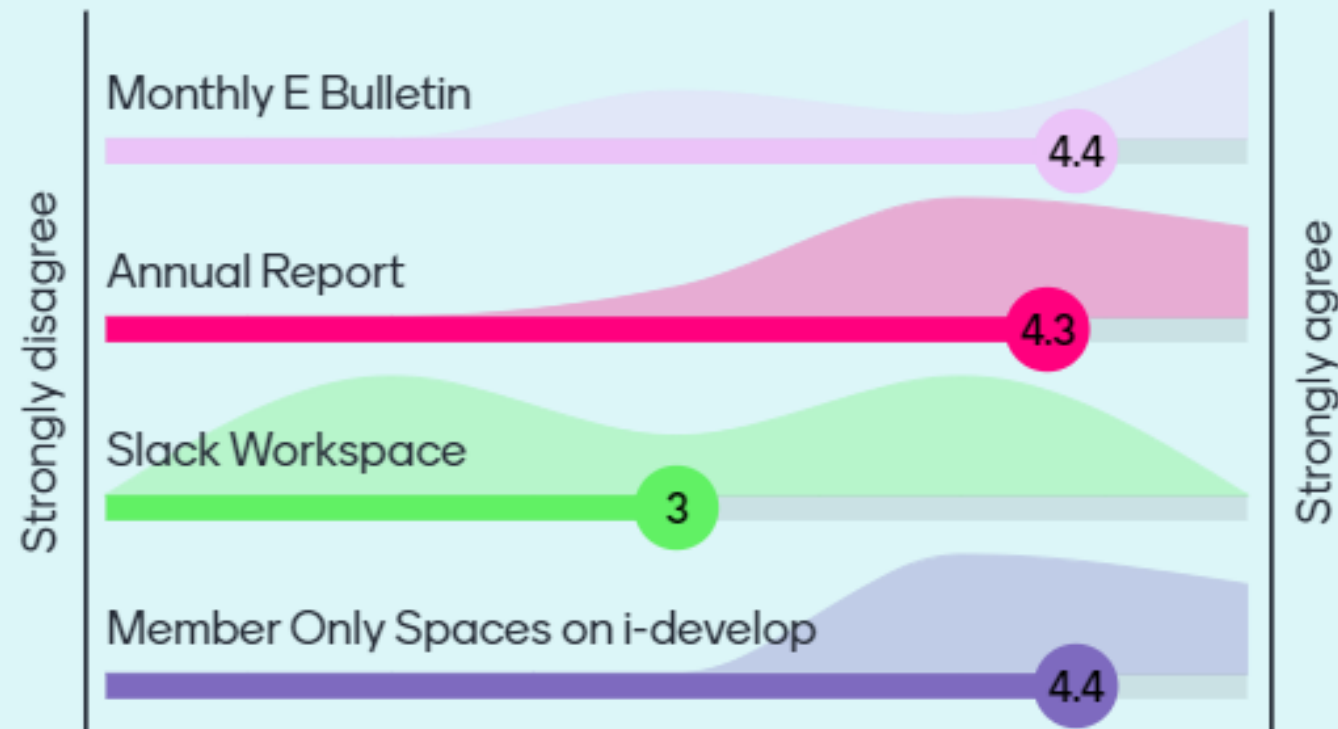

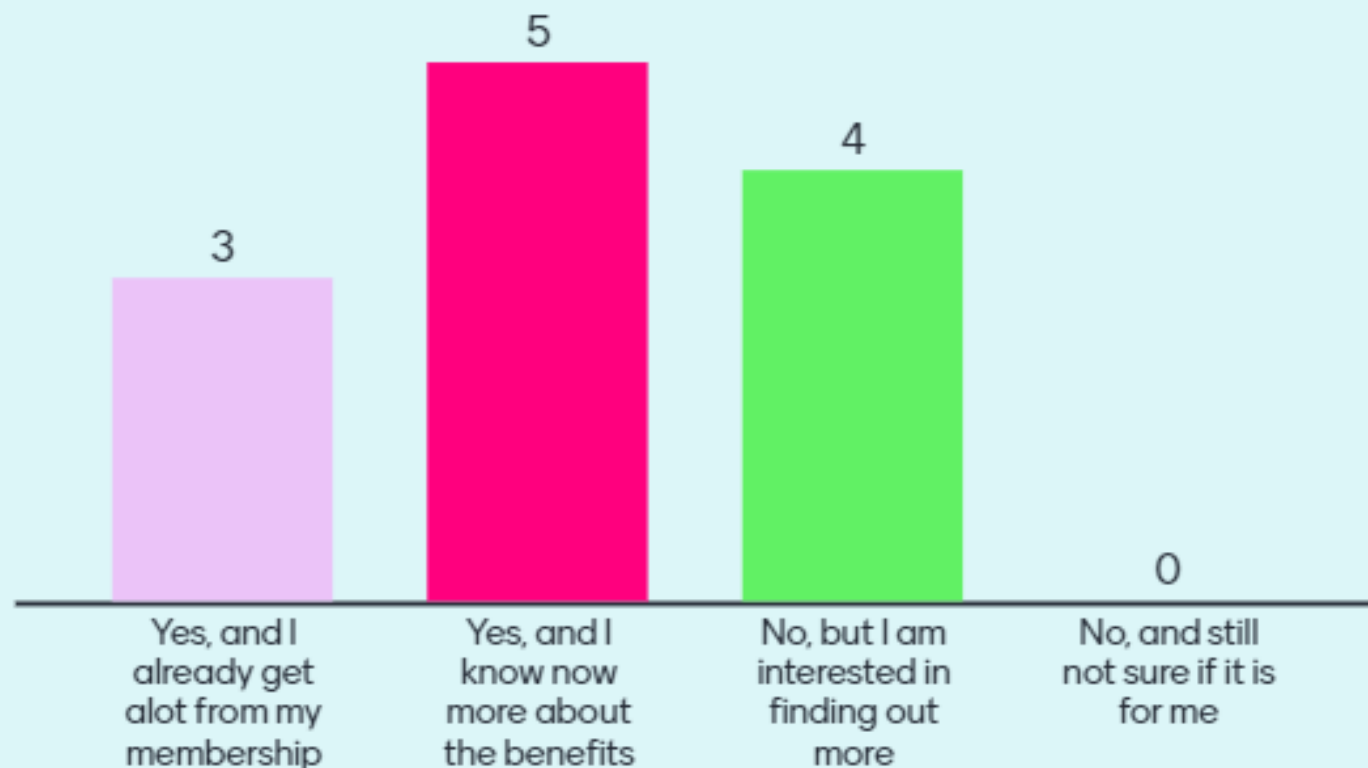
