Navigating your learning and collaboration spaces

Frequently Asked Questions

1 I don't know my username/password.

If you do not have your password and / or username, click the 'Lost password' link at the log in area of the front page. You can then provide your email and your username will be emailed to you along with a new reset password which you can change once logged in.

If you no longer have access to the email you used to create the account please email the previous email, your Registration number or rough date you registered and postal address to <u>contact@cldstandardscouncil.org.uk</u>

2 How private are the forum posts, personal details and documents that I add to idevelop?

- Your details can only be viewed by you and those you give access to such as a mentor and administrators of the system.
- Member forum posts are only visible to those who are members of the same group.
- Forum posts on the main CPD forum and other forums are visible to anyone who visits the site.
