





# Many of our priorities should flow from the National Delivery Plan






Showing how we will maximise the CLD contribution to driving improvement on the National Delivery Plan's three themes:

# **The National Improvement Framework**


Showing how we will maximise our contribution to strengthening the NIF's six key drivers
