Toolkit

Evaluation Target

<u>Purpose</u>

To evaluate general issues about the programme.

What you need

Flipchart paper with pre-written 'target', pens sticky dots in four different colours.

How you do it:

- a) On flipchart paper draw a large circle with a smaller circle in the middle and a cross running through the centre point to the outer circle (to look like a target)
- b) In each of the 4 sections place a heading (make heading same colour as sticky dot).

Examples include:

- Venue
- Fun
- Group leaders
- Activities
- c) Provide participants with a sticky dot of each colour. Explain that all staff will leave the room and each participant has to place the dots on the target. If they think the venue was very good they would place a red dot near the centre of the venue section. If they think the content was okay they would place the purple dot further from the centre in that section.
- d) Have a piece of flipchart paper next to the 'target'. It should be headed and show which coloured sticker to use for each quadrant. The words can be changed for each quadrant to suit the group/activity/feedback required as long as the colour coded key reflects which colour to use for which quadrant.



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
