

Scenario Building – Storyboarding

A method of using symbols pictures and metaphors to build up a storyboard which would prioritise different stages of the development.

When focussing on a specific issue or topic, building a scenario of events in the form of a storyboard enables the group members to highlight the key features of development. The storyboard takes the form of six to eight frames each depicting a different scenario leading to achieving the overall goal. Give out a range of sticky post it notes and ask people to think of all the actions that need to take place and as a group agree in which stage / section they should be placed. This can be done by using words or metaphors / symbols / pictures / images.
